By scheduling a fleet oiler to fuel us enroute, our scheduled fueling stop at Rota, Spain, has been canceled, and we are now scheduled to arrive at the Destroyer-Submarine Piers, Norfolk, at eleven A.M., Saturday, 17 December. All of us consider this two day earlier arrival an extra Christmas gift.

Our trip home has been pleasant and interesting. Penang, Malaysia, was a pretty, quiet town where the people were extremely friendly. Cochin, India, gave us a good opportunity to see some of India and develop a better understanding of the country. Our fueling stop in Aden was for eight hours only. However, a large number of the crew had the opportunity to visit the Royal Navy Base for a few hours.
